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## CURRENT funding & tenders.

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### ➤ **EC: 'THE DIGITAL EUROPE PROGRAMME – WORK PROGRAMMES'**

The *European Commission* has published the **work programme** with the call topics **for the years 2025 to 2027**. The aim of *Digital Europe* is to drive the digital transformation in Europe and strengthen Europe's digital competitiveness.

The healthcare sector is an important area for creating advanced applications such as 'Virtual Human Twins' and AI-based solutions for medical imaging, diagnostics, screening and treatment.

The following call topics are relevant for the **health sector**:

- ✕ **"Health: Data ingestion capacities and data services for the European genomic data infrastructure in the European Health Data Space"**  
**Budget:** 25 mil. €, **open:** Q4-2025 **deadline:** Q1-2026
- ✕ **"Deployment of cutting-edge multi-modal AI-based solutions in medical imaging"**  
**Budget:** 16 mil. €, **open:** Q4-2025 **deadline:** Q1-2026
- ✕ **"Apply AI: Piloting AI based image screening in medical centres"**  
**Budget:** 10 mil. €, **open:** Q2-2026 **deadline:** Q3-2026
- ✕ **"Virtual Human Twins and Artificial Intelligence in health platform validation and uptake incubator"**  
**Budget:** 9 mil. €, **open:** Q1-2027 **deadline:** Q2-2027

### ➤ **ERC: PROOF OF CONCEPT GRANTS**

"The *ERC Proof of Concept Grants* aim at facilitating exploration of the commercial and social innovation potential of ERC funded research and are therefore available only to Principal Investigators whose proposals draw substantially on their ERC funded research.

Principal Investigators in an **ongoing ERC main grant**, or Principal Investigators **in an ERC main grant that has ended after January 1<sup>st</sup> 2024**, are eligible to apply.

The financial contribution will be awarded as a lump sum of **150.000,- €** for a period of **18 months**."

### ➤ **HADEA TENDER: "DEVELOPMENT OF A RAPID POINT-OF-CARE ANTIMICROBIAL SUSCEPTIBILITY TESTING DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL DEVICE"**

**Reference:** HADEA/2025/CPN/0006-PIN

**Application deadline:** **May 12<sup>th</sup> 2025**, 04:00 p.m.

**Budget:** 12,86 mil. €

**Aim:** This call for tenders aims to speed up the development of a point-of-care diagnostic medical device that can provide antimicrobial susceptibility results on the bacteria or fungi causing an infection in humans, within one hour or less from subject sample collection, and ideally, to also allow for pathogen identification.

➤ **HADEA TENDER: “MULTIPLE SOURCING FRAMEWORK CONTRACTS TO SPEED UP THE DEVELOPMENT OF AND ACCESS TO INNOVATIVE MEDICAL COUNTERMEASURES: NEXT-GENERATION INFLUENZA VACCINES”**

**Application deadline:** **May 19<sup>th</sup> 2025**, 03:00 p.m.

**Budget:** 147,95 mil. €

**Aim:** This call for tenders aims to **speed up the development of next generation influenza vaccines** that could be produced in rapidly scalable manufacturing platforms, could support products utilising novel administration routes, confer mucosal immunity, target potentially pandemic influenza A viruses or could be rapidly adapted to pandemic influenza A viruses.

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➤ **EIC: BOARD SEARCHES FOR NEW ADVISORS**

The *EIC* is guided by a board that advises the *European Commission* on **strategy, funding allocation, project selection and innovation trends**. It also helps identify regulatory barriers, supports innovation ecosystems, and promotes the *EIC* brand. Board members serve **two-year terms** and act as ambassadors for the *EIC*.

The **application deadline** is **May 19<sup>th</sup> 2025**, 12:00 p.m.

➤ **EC: CALL FOR EVIDENCE**

“Research & technology infrastructures provide scientific & technological capacities essential for the excellence and the competitiveness of European research, innovation, and industrial ecosystems. However, budget and other constraints ever more hinder the creation, operation and upgrades of these infrastructures and the effective access to their services. The strategy will increase their complementarity and service offer and promote pooling and prioritization of investments, leading to improved capacity and reduced investment risks and costs.”

The **submission deadline** is **May 22<sup>nd</sup> 2025**.

➤ **EC - JOINT RESEARCH CENTER: ‘IMPROVING BREAST CANCER SCREENING AND CARE’**

“The *European Quality Assurance Scheme for Breast Cancer Services* is now available for implementation by breast cancer services, improving the screening and care offerings for breast cancer. This voluntary scheme is the **first official version**. It encompasses requirements and indicators across the breast cancer care pathway covering **breast cancer screening, diagnosis to treatment and palliative care**, focusing on quality improvement and equal access to quality healthcare.”

➤ **ECIS: NEW DATA RELEASED**

“The release of the **latest cancer data from European population-based cancer registries** is available on the *European Cancer Information System* web application. *ECIS* provides **up to date, reliable statistics on cancer burden in Europe** and works closely with the European Network of Cancer Registries (ENCR).

The published data is the fruit of collaboration between the cancer registries and the EC.”

➤ **ECIR: COUNTRY CANCER PROFILES 2025**

“The *Country Cancer Profiles* series, published under the umbrella of the *European Cancer Inequalities Registry*, provides a **regular reporting mechanism to assess cancer care and inequalities across the 27 EU Member States, Norway and Iceland**.

The *2025 Country Cancer Profiles* provide the **latest insights on cancer burden, prevention and care across European countries**. The new edition includes a Synthesis report, highlighting the key findings and developments that emerge from the Country Profiles at the EU level.”

➤ **EIC: IMPACT REPORT 2025**

The report highlights the **achievements and objectives of the EIC**, focussing on the impact of the *Accelerator projects*. Furthermore, it contains **case studies** on innovation pathways through various *EIC* instruments. A total of 1.350 innovations from *Pathfinder* and *Transition* projects were funded.
