• DFG | Call for proposals - Large-scale equipment initiative 2026

The *German Research Foundation (DFG)* invites scientists to **submit topic proposals** for the establishment of a large-scale equipment initiative.

The DFG funds projects that make the latest and most complex large-scale equipment and facilities, with outstanding and particularly promising technology, available for research. The **submission deadline** is **June 10**th **2025**.

• The German Alliance for Global Health Research (GLOHRA)

The *GLOHRA* is celebrating its **five-year anniversary in 2025**. The association, made up of researchers from public German institutions, emphasizes the importance of diversity and networking in advancing global health. The initiative **connects academics, funds research projects, and supports early-career researchers**. Key initiatives include Germany's first Global Health Research Directory, featuring over 1,300 researchers from 200+ institutions, and the Global Health Academy, offering resources and networking opportunities for PhD's and postdocs.

• Novartis Graduate Award – Reminder

The award, endowed with **8.000,-** €, is specifically for **young researchers with doctoral degrees** who are still at the beginning of their scientific careers and have already attracted attention through outstanding achievements.

The application deadline is May 18th 2025.

• BMBF | Promotion of joint strategic project funding programmes with the Republic of India Funding is provided with up to 500.000 € for bilateral R&D projects involving science and industry. The involvement of German SMEs in particular is intended to ensure a high level of practical relevance and subsequent commercial usability of the research results, in order to make an overall contribution to a more sustainable economy. The funded projects should also serve to prepare applications for follow-up projects.

The **submission deadline** for the first step (2-step application process) is **May 20th 2025** . More information can be found **here** (GER).

• Hertie Foundation | medMS Doctoral Programme

"The Hertie Foundation supports and promotes scientific research in the neurological illness multiple sclerosis.

The doctoral programme is designed to create incentives for medical students interested in scientific study to focus on the topic of multiple sclerosis in their dissertation and/or enhance the scientific quality of the work.

The main award is a **12-month grant** during the practical phase of the doctoral program, in which the study of medicine is interrupted for at least six months to allow full-time work on the dissertation. The doctoral mentor receives funding of **5.000 € for equipment**."

The application deadline is June 15th 2025.

• Volkswagen Foundation | Impetus for the German Science System

"Funding will be provided for **strategic concepts at universities** within which new approaches are tested, that previously could **not** be **implemented due to legal or bureaucratic regulations**. Applicant universities are therefore encouraged to enter into a dialogue with the relevant ministries in order to create the necessary exceptions and special regulations. The aim is to test within the funded projects whether a higher degree of freedom should be granted permanently and systematically, i.e. state- or nationwide, to other universities in the future. If successful, the experimental spaces should thus serve as a model for other institutions and federal states, thereby improving the structural conditions for exploratory, pioneering research."

Budget: up to 500.000,-€

The application deadline is September 30th 2025.

• G-BA | Innovation Committee is looking for topic proposals for the 2026 funding year
The Innovation Committee at the Federal Joint Committee (G-BA) launched the search for
healthcare-relevant topic proposals for the 2026 funding year. The aim is to incorporate a wide
range of ideas into the new funding announcements. Proposals may relate to new forms of
healthcare and healthcare research.

• Volkswagen Foundation | Night Science

The *Night Science* funding initiative supports the development of creative skills in research and the exploration of **unconventional ideas**, hypotheses, or theories. It seeks interdisciplinary teams of **two researchers** who inspire, complement, and challenge one another. The initiative aims to create a space for new approaches to emerge, free from the pressure of immediate results, encouraging fresh perspectives and innovation through collaborative scientific work. **Budget**: up to 200.000,- €

• Bf3R | Research Funding - Replacement, Reduction and Refinement

"Every two years, the German Centre for the Protection of Laboratory Animals (Bf3R) at the German Federal Institute for Risk Assessment (BfR) awards funds for scientific research projects addressing the **3R principle** (Replace, Reduce, Refine). Funded are projects that serve to replace and reduce the use of laboratory animals in areas of medical research or basic biological research, or that aim to identify, classify, and reduce pain, suffering, or harm in laboratory animals and improve husbandry conditions. With an annual total budget of approximately **350.000,-** €, innovative projects of high scientific quality are funded for a total duration of up to 3 years. "

The submission deadline is May 31st 2025.

• canSERV | Open Call for Transnational Service Provision

Under the open call, researchers are welcome to apply to a portfolio of services offered by *canSERV* to address the research needs of the entire **oncology developmental pipeline**. The research project can range from basic discovery science to translational science, including personalized oncology. It should **address at least one of the** *Cancer Mission's* **four strategic goals**: understanding cancer, prevention and early detection, diagnosis and treatment, or improving the quality of life for patients and their families.

The overall budget for this call is **1.5 mil. €**.

The submission deadline is July 15th 2025, 02:00 p.m..

Sobek Research Award 2025 and Sobek Young Talent Award 2025

The Sobek Research Prize, endowed with **100.000,-** €, is one of the most highly endowed awards for **MS research** in Europe. It recognizes scientists for **outstanding and pioneering research** work on an international scale and can be awarded for both individual scientific excellence and excellent overall scientific achievement.

The Sobek Young Scientist Award is endowed with **15.000,-** € and is awarded to young researchers who have already made an impression with their outstanding scientific work in the **field of multiple sclerosis or related sciences**.

The submission deadline is May 30th 2025.

Deutsche Hochschulmedizin e.V. | German University Medicine Prize 2025

Outstanding **team achievements** in the field of basic medical research, as well as clinical or translational research in the **field of university medicine**, are to be honoured. The aim of the award, which is endowed with **25.000,-** €, is to strengthen research in university medicine in Germany as a centre of science.

The evaluation of the team and its performance is primarily based on a **max. 3-minute video**. In it, the team should present its research project and its (social) impact.

The application deadline is July 6th 2025.

Rosemarie Germscheid Foundation | research prize

The research prize is primarily aimed at issues relating to the needs of **rheumatism sufferers**, research into **rheumatic diseases**, self-help research in **rheumatology**, social participation and the health literacy of sufferers.

Researchers can apply by submitting an outline of their ideas or by submitting published scientific articles.

The two best entries will each be awarded with 5.000,- €.

The **submission deadline** is **July 31**st **2025**.

DKFZ | Patient Expert Award

This award is intended to recognize patient representatives who have made an outstanding contribution to **cancer research** in Germany.

The award honours patient involvement in all areas of cancer research.

It is endowed with 5.000,- € and will be awarded on July 16th 2025.

• EKFS | Else Kröner Excellence Grants 2025

The Excellence Grants exist to enable outstanding scientists from the US to continue their medical research in Germany. Medical faculties and universities wishing to host a US-based scientist at their research facility in Germany are eligible to apply for funding. The foundation has earmarked a total of 10 mil. € for this initiative.

The **deadline** for the first call for proposals is **June 15**th **2025**.

• Bio-Security | Bio-Founder Competition

Every year, the *Bio-Security Competence Centre* organizes a competition for **start-ups and** young entrepreneurs from the agricultural and food industry, biotechnology and biochemistry or related sectors.

The winners will receive cash and non-cash prizes worth up to 4.000,- €.
